David is graduate of Ruskin College, Oxford where he gained a First Class BA (Hons) in English & Creative Writing in 2008.

Prior to university, between 1986-1994, he was an education assistant for *Film Education*, the industry-backed organisation set up by David Puttnam.

He also worked as a Publicity Assistant for Columbia Pictures, co-ordinating the promotion of, amongst others, *Labyrinth*, *About last Night* and *Care Bears 2: Their Next Adventure*.

Between 1993 and 1998, David was employed solidly for BBC Radio in the Light Entertainment Department. He was writer/researcher/interviewer of 2 series (twice weekly) of *Steve Wright at The Movies* for Radio 2 which was the highest rated radio film show; he was writer and presenter of *In the Cannes* a 60 minute documentary on the Cannes Film Festival, broadcast on Christmas Day 1996; writer and researcher of *Carry On Carrying On* (60 minute, Radio 2); Interviewer of over 50 guests including Bruce Willis, Dustin Hoffman, Alan Parker and Keanu Reeves for *Cinema 2* (radio 2).

In addition, he has been a script reader for Northern Ireland Screen and Screen Yorkshire.
